From Wall Street to the Operating Room: Responsible AI Lessons Cosmetic Surgery Can't Afford to Miss

Responsible AI (Artificial Intelligence) is already reshaping industries like finance, insurance, and healthcare, where safety, compliance, and trust are mission-critical. Xiaochen Zhang will discuss how cosmetic surgery can apply those same lessons to harness AI responsibly, mitigate risks, and deliver safer, more transparent patient care.

Xiaochen Zhang is the Executive Director and Chief AI Officer of AI 2030, a global initiative dedicated to mainstreaming responsible AI to benefit humanity. A recognized leader in applying emerging technologies for social impact, he has over two decades of experience at the intersection of AI, fintech, blockchain, and sustainability.

Expert on Body Dysmorphic Disorder

Body dysmorphic disorder (BDD) — an often-severe psychiatric disorder that cosmetic surgeons often encounter — virtually never improves with cosmetic treatment. Dr. Phillips will discuss what BDD is, risks of surgery and other cosmetic procedures for patients and clinicians alike, how to identify BDD, and tips for managing patients with BDD in cosmetic surgery settings.

Dr. Katharine Phillips is a world-renowned expert in body dysmorphic disorder (BDD), with over 20 years of continuous NIMH-funded research. She has published 375+ articles and chapters, authored or edited 11 books, and delivered 650+ presentations worldwide. Recognized for her contributions to research, clinical care, and education, she has received numerous honors, including a Special Presidential Commendation from the American Psychiatric Association and the 2023 Outstanding Career Achievement Award from the International OCD Foundation.






